

# WHAT IF I GET **INJURED AT WORK?**

#### IF YOUR INJURY IS JOB-RELATED, YOU ARE **COVERED UNDER WORKERS' COMPENSATION REGARDLESS OF WHO CAUSED THE ACCIDENT.**

- $\checkmark$ Immediately report injury to your employer and request the claim form that the law says an employer must provide
- Request that your employer refer you to a  $\square$ medical care provider
- DO NOT speak to the insurance company  $\square$ representative without your lawyer
